

**CCQHA 2010 HORSE SALE CONSIGNMENT CONTRACT  
CATALOG INFORMATION DEADLINE: JULY 1, 2010**

**CONSIGNMENT FEE: \$75 Weanlings, \$100 Lead or Ride Horses**

**Your information needs to be Catalog Ready, so have all the information included so it can be delivered to the printer in one envelope.**

**INCLUDE: A completed and signed Consignment Contract (page 3) for each horse, with payment, make check payable to CCQHA, along with a COPY OF THEIR REGISTRATION PAPER, or a copy of the application for registration, and a FOOTNOTE, (NOT OVER 70 WORDS), make a NOTATION if the horse is by a nominated stallion, or is eligible to compete in CCQHA Futurities, or any other competitions, and a HARD COPY PICTURE of your consignment. Also, be sure to sign and include the bottom half of Page 2, the waiver for a bond for the State of Montana. All consignments will be approved by the Sale Committee.**

**If all of the above are not received by JULY 1, 2010, your horse will not be in the catalog, or the sale. Incomplete consignment information will not be accepted.**

**ALL ORIGINAL REGISTRATIONS (and a signed transfer) are required when the horse is checked in, BEFORE 4 P.M., Friday, September 3, 2010, along with a brand inspection (or permit made out to Miles City Livestock), if coming from out of the county, or the horse will not be allowed to sell. Consignment fees will not be returned.**

**STALLS WILL BE PRE-ASSIGNED.**

**Please have someone with your horse at your pen, with all the required paperwork, before the Brand Inspector arrives.**

**Upon check in, the Brand Inspector will give you one set of hip numbers per horse.**

**Once the hip numbers are put on your horse, do not remove them, even after the horse sells.**

**Each horse leaving the sale grounds is required to have a current brand inspection (which is the bill of sale) issued after the sale by the brand inspector.**

**This includes no-sale horses.**

**You may put a reserve price on your horse and if the auctioneer announces that the reserve has not been met, you may sell your horse in the alley after the sale, but the check has to be made out to CCQHA and turned in to the Sale Secretary the day of the sale.**

**Sale expense fee: 8% commission with a maximum of \$150 and minimum of \$10 no-sale fee. This is in addition to your consignment fee. There will be a 10% commission (plus the consignment fee) on any consigned horse sold prior to the sale. All Consignors are encouraged to advertise in the catalog for one-half price. Ads have to be submitted by June 15, 2010.**

**Substitutions will be accepted if they are of equal or better quality than the original horse.**

**This is your horse sale, please help with it as much as you can. This sale will be widely publicized with posters, the internet, the radio, newspapers, as well as the catalog.**

**All rules are for everyone to follow, or you will not be eligible to consign the following year.**
