PREVIEW OF ALL SALE HORSES

BEGINNING WITH RIDE HORSES:

It is suggested that the rider be able to open and close a gate from the back of the horse, go over a bridge, pick up a slicker from the fence, rub it on the horse, drag and/or rope a roping dummy, or anything you want to do to show your horse can handle a rope, and, if desired, walk over a tarp on the ground, do a short reining pattern, lope both directions in the correct lead, showing lead changes, stopping ability, backing. You may pick up their feet, and anything else you want to show your horse. There may be a time limit.

LEAD HORSES:

Lead horses will be required to go through a pattern, lope both directions in the correct lead, get rubbed with a slicker, etc.

WEANLINGS MAY ALSO BE SHOWN IF DESIRED.

THIS IS YOUR SALE, DO WHAT YOU CAN TO SHOW YOUR HORSE TO THE BUYERS!

PLEASE HELP CLEAN UP AND TEAR DOWN THE PENS IF REQUIRED, AND HELP CLEAN UP INSIDE THE BUILDING AND ALSO THE OUTSIDE STALLS AND OUTSIDE ARENA, OTHERWISE THE FAIR BOARD WILL CHARGE CCQHA A CLEAN-UP CHARGE AND IT WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM YOUR PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE.
