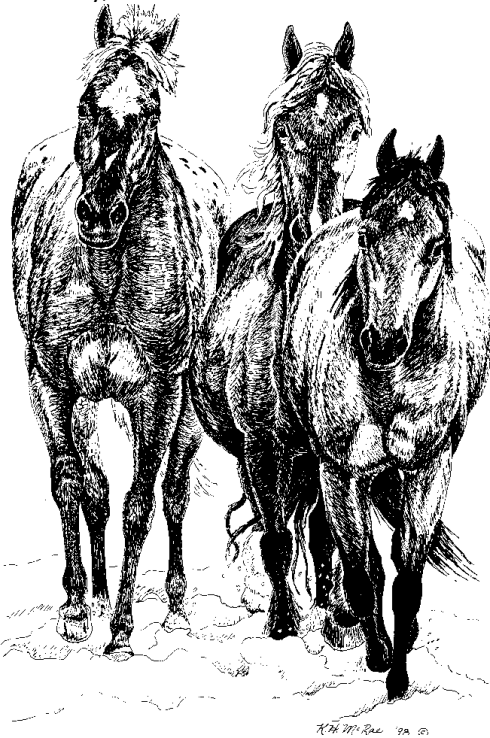

Sales Committee Appointees Change:

Sometime after the April 6, 2009 meeting of the CCQHA, Julie Korkow stepped down as one of the CCQHA Directors.

By unanimous vote at the May 4, 2009 CCQHA General meeting, she was replaced by Sandy Jensen.

The CCQHA would like to thank Julie for all the time and effort she has given to the club, and would also like to welcome and thank Sandy Jensen for the time and effort she has volunteered to commit by accepting the nomination of Director

Also at the May 4 meeting of the CCQHA, Heidi Petermann announced that she was stepping down as Sale Secretary. It was decided that there wasn't enough time to appoint/hire a new Sale Secretary; therefore the duties of the Sales Secretary will be carried out by the sales committee.

At the same meeting Sandy Wilson turned in her resignation as Sale Committee Chair, and was replaced by vote of the present members by Vicky Crofutt.

At some point since that meeting, we were informed that Vicky Crofutt has declined the election of Sale Committee Chairman.

As of press date, the CCQHA News has not been informed of any member being nominated for replacing Sandy Wilson/Vicky Crofutt.

New Web Site Up and Running:

The new CCQHA website is finally up and running. You can view the new site at ccqha.org. The website is still in its infancy, and there are many inaccuracies that need to be corrected on it.

Also, we need pictures! Anyone with any CCQHA related pictures are requested to submit them to info@ccqha.org along with a short description of who/what the picture is of. Please don't be afraid to send in pictures, or send an email to the above address with any mistakes you find on the website, so that we may correct them.

We included a disclaimer on the home page that the information may be incorrect. I hope no one gets upset if they find a statement on the web site that is totally wrong. We will correct anything that is brought to our attention.

Also on the website is a list of the Nominated Stallions and Mares. If you have a horse on that list, and you have your own web site promoting your horse operation, please email us the web address of your site. We will add a link to your site, from the Nominated Stallions list.

End of Sale Slots:

At the May 4, 2009 CCQHA Meeting, the members present voted to abandon the pre-paid sale slots, in favor of returning to the old method.

Under the new (old) plan, persons selling a horse in the September 4, 2009 [CCQHA Horse Sale](#) will have to pay a \$100 catalog fee by June 1, 2009. The CCQHA will then collect 8% of the sale price when the horse sells in September.

This change was made in order to promote more participation in the sale, as several people have said they would put a horse in the sale if we went back to the old way, but would not participate in the Sale Slot method.

There has been some talk of capping the 8% commission at \$250, but we'll have to wait until the

June 1, 2009 meeting to see if anyone makes a motion to do this.

Here are some dates to clear up some of the confusion about consigning a horse to the Sale:

June 1, 2009 - \$100 Catalog Fee due per horse to be consigned. Note the horse to be sold doesn't have to be named until July 1, 2009, but you need to pay the Catalog Fee by June 1, 2009.

July 1, 2009 – Consignor Contract, Consignment Form, Horse Registration, and a picture for the catalog is due for each horse to be in the sale.

Nominated Stallions/Mare:

CCQHA Nominated Stallions will be featured in the Sale Catalog with their offspring that are in the sale.

NEW in 2009! Stallions nominated for 2009 will be eligible to compete in the 2009 Breeder's Futurities on September 4, 2009. This is limited to Stallions only, ages 2 – 5 years old.

by Email!**

While the CCQHA Newsletter is currently available in either electronic (email) or printed formats, the club encourages anyone who can, to sign up to receive the newsletter by email.

This saves the club postage, toner, paper, wear and tear on our printers, and loads of time each month!

The added benefits to you are:

Receive the newsletter sooner!

Because this is a volunteer organization, information for the newsletter such as the minutes from the last meeting, and current club events are not always submitted in time to get the newsletter out by mail before the events actually happen.

Receive club updates between newsletters:

We make every effort to include only accurate and up to date information in the newsletter, but sometimes we find information or realize there was a mistake in the newsletter after it has already been mailed. Club members who receive the newsletter by email can also receive email alerts of club events and breaking news after the newsletter that they would not normally receive if they get the newsletter by mail.
