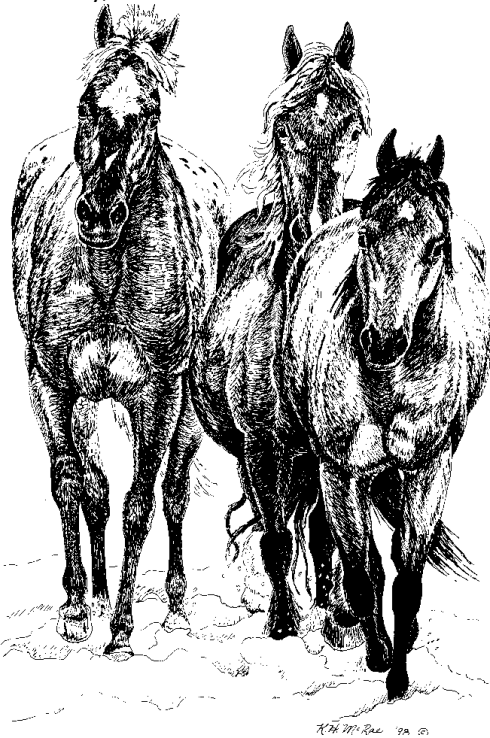

Nominate Your Stallion for 2009!

By nominating your stallion in the CCQHA for 2009, you receive the following benefits:

- Offspring of your nominated Stallion that are born in 2009 are eligible for all CCQHA Breeder's Futurities for the rest of their lives.
- If those offspring are sold in a CCQHA Horse Sale, they also become eligible to participate in any of the CCQHA Sale Futurities, giving your Stallion's offspring the added value of being eligible to win money in both types of events.
- Your stallion will be listed on the CCQHA website, with a link to your own website (if you have one)
- **NEW IN 2009!** Any stallion nominated in 2009 is eligible to compete in the CCQHA 2009 Breeder's Futurities Sep. 3rd & 4th in his own class. Classes available are 2 year old, 3 year old, 4 & 5 year old.

Any horse participating in the Breeder's Futurities must have been born in the year that either it's Sire or Dam was a CCQHA Nominated Sire/Dam, with the exception noted below under "New in 2009!"

Horses participating in the Sale Futurities must have been purchased at a CCQHA Sale. It is possible to have a horse eligible to participate in both Futurities, and win money from both events.

Classes will be judged on 70% Movement and 30% Conformation.

Breeder's Futurities class will be separate from Sale Futurities class, but studs and fillies will be shown together in both classes.

New in 2009! Any Stallion Nominated in 2009 can compete for the Breeder's money in his age class.

The CCQHA paid out almost \$15,000 in Futurity Winnings in 2008!

Any horse can compete in this competition and sale, but the winning horse must be sold in the CCQHA Horse Sale (immediately following this event) or prize money is forfeited.
