

Constitution of the Cow Country Quarter Horse Association

Article I: Name

The name of this organization shall be the "Cow Country Quarter Horse Association", hereinafter referred to as the "Association". The Association's acronym shall be "CCQHA".

Article II: Purpose

The purpose of the Cow Country Quarter Horse Association shall be to stimulate interest in and promotion of horses and horsemanship through education, competition and participation.

Article III: Membership

Membership in the association shall be open to any and all persons or corporations who have a sincere interest in the improvement and promotion of horses.

Article IV: Board of Directors

The Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors elected by the membership.

Article V: Officers

The officers of the Association are to be elected from the Board of Directors.

Article VI: Financial Matters

The Association may raise and disburse funds to further its purpose.

Article VII: Amendments to the Constitution

Amendments to this constitution shall be adopted by a majority vote of the members in good standing who are present at the annual membership meeting.

Article VIII: Dissolution

Dissolution of the Association shall be in accordance with the federal laws that govern non profit organizations.
